**A RESOLUTION BY THE VILLAGE OF TIJERAS GOVERNING BODY TO ADOPT THE BERNALILLO COUNTY RURAL ROAD CULVERT GUIDELINES**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tijeras has prioritized improved maintenance and repair of culverts within the Village of Tijeras right of way; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tijeras currently does not have a requirement for the size of culverts places for drainage purposes within the Village of Tijeras right of way; and

**WHEREAS**, historically, culverts placed in the Village of Tijeras right of way have been smaller than what is required by Bernalillo County's Stormwater Quality Ordinance for rural roads; and


**WHEREAS**, Bernalillo County's Stormwater Quality Ordinance Sec. 66-222 G specifies that "no culvert under any driveway access shall be less than 18 inches in diameter unless a variance is approved"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tijeras is committed to following best practices regarding road and drainage improvement projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the governing body of the Village of Tijeras formally adopts the criteria for rural road culverts outlined in Bernalillo County's Stormwater Quality Ordinance Sec. 66-222 G for the Village of Tijeras.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this ordinance will be made available to the public via the website, [tijerasnm.org](http://tijerasnm.org).


