A RESOLUTION BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF TIJERAS TO PROMOTE SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES AT VILLAGE FACILTIES

WHEREAS, the Village of Tijeras is committed to cutting unnecessary costs and the purchasing of superfluous supplies; and

WHEREAS, currently the Village of Tijeras purchases single use paper products, plastic wear, and water bottles to be used by Village employees and guests; and

WHEREAS, this creates an undue financial burden on the Village because reusable alternatives already exist for employees and guests; and

WHEREAS, the Village does not actively have recycling bins in Village Hall and other necessary Village facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Village has not previously obtained a service to process/collect recyclable materials collected at Village facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Village actively throws away many things that are recyclable because there is no established recycling protocol; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF TIJERAS, NEW MEXICO, THAT:

The Village hereby promotes the active collection and processing of recyclable goods at all Village facilities, including the purchasing of designated recycling bins where needed and the hauling of recyclable goods to the East Mountain Transfer Station on an as-needed basis.

NOW, LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF TIJERAS, NEW MEXICO, THAT:

The Village hereby promotes the use of reusable goods, such as water bottles, dishes, silverware, and coffee mugs, and the purchasing of water bottle refilling stations where needed.
