The 2020 Census and Why it is Important Maxine Wilson

The media headlines these days are mostly about the COVID-19 pandemic and nationwide protests. While those issues are important, I would like to mention another ongoing event that will have an impact on our community.

The 2020 Census counts every person living in the United States and five U.S. Territories. The count is mandated by the Constitution and conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau. Each home received an invitation to respond to a short questionnaire—online, by phone, or by mail. The census provides critical data that lawmakers, business owners, teachers, and many others use to provide daily services, products, and support for our community.

Every year, billions of dollars in federal funding go to schools, roads, senior centers like ours and other resources based on census data. If you haven't done so, please fill out the 2020 Census. Go to https://2020census.gov for more information on how to fill out the Census online.

Last week site preparation began by putting in place storm water and run off prevention, which is visible by driving by the site. Keeping in mind the aquifer during the drilling process, a surface casting was set to protect it. With all of the preparations set in place the rig was able to arrive on site the first week of June. The pilot hole drilling is set to begin Monday, 6/22. It is estimated that this process will take about a week to complete.
