
The Village of Tijeras is partnering with Vitalant New Mexico to host a blood drive on June 8th from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The drive will be held here at Village Hall in our Council Chamber. An appointment is required to donate blood. If you have any questions, feel free to contact us at 505-281-1220.

Donating blood is a quick and safe way to perform an extremely important service for your community. In the United States, someone needs a blood transfusion every two seconds. Your donation will help save lives. Moreover, when you donate blood your donation undergoes 13 tests, 11 of which are for infectious diseases. Therefore, by donating you not only help others but help yourself, as the results of these tests could identify a potential health issue early.

Construction on the project to renovate and expand the Village of Tijeras Senior Center is well underway! Our contractor, Vigil Contracting Services, have made substantial progress on a new shade structure and outdoor exercise circuit, and recently began their excavation of the site. The expanded Senior Center will include additional space for our kitchen and dining room, new classrooms, a larger fitness room, and additional restrooms. We hope to hold a grand reopening at the beginning of next year.







LOS VALLECITOS SLOPE STABILIZATION

As those of you who live in the area know, the lower stretch of Los Vallecitos Road off Camino Primera Agua was a hazardous spot and a source of concern for many of our residents and neighbors. A steep slope to the north of the roadway and erosion from rainstorms created the risk of large rocks and other debris sliding down the hillside and into the road.

The Village used capital outlay funding from the state to design and implement a project to address these issues and improve safety on Los Vallecitos. The project involved stabilization of the slope and putting down layers of wire mesh and a concrete product known as shotcrete to control the slope and prevent future erosion.

We would like to thank our contractor for this project, TLC, for all their hard work. Los Vallecitos is now much safer for passing motorists. The safety and wellbeing of our residents and community is our top priority!
