## **ROAD PROJECT UPDATES**

The Village has been busy working to keep our community safe and ensure the roads our residents and neighbors drive on are in good condition. We would like to take a moment to update you on several of our recently-completed projects, as well as a few others that are still in progress.

We recently completed paving projects on Gonzales Road, Torres Trail, and Rincon Loop West. All three roads look excellent and we are grateful to our contractors for their high-quality work. We also replaced several culverts on the east side of Rincon Loop and Pine View Road, which should help improve drainage in both locations.


We have a contractor currently working on an erosion control project on Los Vallecitos Road, which will greatly improve the safety of our residents. This summer we plan to widen Celina Lane to accommodate two vehicles and pave Wilson Lane.

The Village is committed to conserving our scarce water resources. If you purchase a water conservation product, such as a low flow toilet or shower head water restrictor, you can receive a credit on your water bill of 10 percent of the purchase value, up to \$50.00 annually.
