Mayor Jake Bruton stated this item is due to a law firm in Santa Fe being the manager of the grants for the Water Trust Board. The agreement is about 15 pages long.

Mayor Jake Bruton also stated that 1.43 million is the total cost. 114 thousand is loan, 1 million is grant and 172,000 local match.
