

PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Recently, residents have reached out to our staff regarding the pedestrian improvement project that is taking place along Highway 333. I would like to take a moment to provide a statement regarding the project, its goals, and its benefits to the Village.

The purpose of the project is to improve the availability of pedestrian infrastructure in the Village. Although our community does not experience heavy pedestrian traffic, we do have several residents and neighbors who walk through the community, whether for exercise or simply to get from Point A to Point B. Many students of the local schools utilize the sidewalks after school to reach the library and other points in the Village. It is important to us that pedestrians have safe facilities on which to travel.

Currently, there are two disconnected segments of sidewalk within Village limits: one that begins near the western boundary of the Village and terminates in front of the First Baptist Church, and another that begins just east of Molly's Bar and continues into the Primera Agua neighborhood. The goal of the current project is to connect these two segments of sidewalk, creating continuous pedestrian access through much of the Village. In the future, we hope to continue bringing the sidewalks east, for instance to Village Hall, as well as connect our sidewalks with the walking path on the east side of NM-14.

This project is being funded through a federal transportation grant administered by NMDOT and is not pulling funding away from the Village's other projects. The general contractor on the project, Star Paving, was selected through a competitive sealed bid process.

COMMUNITY BROADBAND

On July 7th, Mayor Jake Bruton and members of staff attended an announcement by Senators Martian Heinrich and Ben Ray Lujan of an exciting community broadband project coming to the East Mountains.

Federal, state, and local leaders gathered at Los Vecinos Community Center for the announcement that National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) has awarded a grant in the amount of \$49,858,624 to the Clovis-based Plateau Telecommunications to expand reliable, affordable, high-speed internet for East Mountains residents along NM-14 and NM-337. The funding will be delivered through the Middle Mile Broadband Infrastructure grant program.

The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law aims to fund critical infrastructure projects. Senator Heinrich voiced his support for efforts to bring high speed internet to additional areas of New Mexico, stating "Every person needs reliable internet access – whether it's to do homework, operate a small business, or to access telemedicine. I'm proud to have helped secure this important federal funding that will plug more of our communities into the 21st century, boost our economy, and grow a stronger middle class."

Senator Lujan also commented, "Homegrown New Mexico broadband providers have an inherent incentive to serve the community because it means connecting family, neighbors, and local schools. . . Thanks to the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, I'm proud to welcome over \$49 million in investments from NTIA to Plateau Telecommunications for middle mile infrastructure. That means direct support for our local provider to build alternate paths, increase resiliency, and deliver faster speeds. These investments will bring faster, stronger, and more affordable connections to our rural communities in eastern New Mexico – an important step toward bridging the digital divide."
