The Village of Tijeras donated a firetruck to the City of Guaymas in the state of Sonora in Mexico!


Mayor Jake Bruton drove the truck to Guaymas earlier this month.

Why Is It Called the Buck Moon?
The full Moon names used by The Old Farmer's
Almanac come from a number of places, including
Native American, Colonial American, and European
sources. Traditionally, each full Moon name was
applied to the entire lunar month in which it
occurred, not solely to the full Moon.

When to See the Full Moon in July 2025
July's full Buck Moon will rise on Thursday, July 11, reaching
peak illumination at 4:37 P.M. Eastern Time. It will be below
the horizon at that time, so plan to look towards the
southeast after sunset to watch it rise into the sky.
