WATER SYSTEM RESILIENCY: GENERATOR GRANT FUNDING

The Village of Tijeras is actively pursuing federal grant funding to purchase backup generators for Village wells and water tanks.

These generators would improve emergency preparedness and help ensure continued water service during power outages and extreme weather events.

Award information is expected within the next few months, and updates will be shared as they become available.

The Village is preparing to begin Pine View Neighborhood – Phase 1 road improvements.
