Message from East Mountain Historical Society

East Mountain Historical Society partners with the Village of Tijeras to promote in Our Past and Faith in our Future with adaptive reuse of the 1889 Stone House!

The Village of Tijeras continues its collaboration with the East Mountain Historical Society (EMHS) under its Memorandum of Understanding to develop the Campo/Sanchez Stone House in San Antonio, located in the Carnuel Land Grant area, by serving as the fiscal agent for the state funding received for site plan services for a future home for the 34-year-old nonprofit organization.

The project design includes a public welcome center for the Turquoise Trail and an educational stop along the Tijeras Creek Cultural Corridor, as well a meeting and office space for EMHS.

EMHS is an all-volunteer organization with nearly 400 members whose mission is to identify, preserve, and present the history and culture of the East Mountain communities to the public. The Village further supports this mission by renting out space in the Tijeras Senior Center for the EMHS Archives. The building plan for the Stone House also includes an addition of approximately 350 square feet dedicated to the modern archive space.

EMHS will present the Master Plan for the restoration of the Stone House at a public meeting at Tijeras Village Hall on June 20, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. All are welcome, and admission and parking are free.
